President's Pen cont.

Sometime in the latter half of 2015, DAMA International and ICCP (Institute for the Certification of Computing Professionals) decided to part ways. DAMA will take over ownership of the testing and certification process for the CDMP (DAMA International has always owned the CDMP designation). ICCP has replaced the CDMP designation with the CDP (Certified Data Professional) and anybody with an active CDMP has probably already received the CDP replacement from ICCP. You can decide to keep the CDP and keep your existing relationship with ICCP -- that is up to you.

As for DAMA, it is expanding the CDMP to four levels: Associate, Practitioner, Master, and Fellow. There will be more stringent requirements for achieving some of the levels (beyond just taking exams), and for the CDMP Fellow designation, you have to be nominated. DAMA also plans to have the chapters worldwide play more of a part in the certification process. I should have more to say about this at our next chapter meeting in April.

I believe these changes are a good thing and will result in the CDMP being of more value to the Data Management profession and to us Data Geeks as a whole. As for timing, the CDMP Associate level exam is supposed to be announced / available at the EDW conference in April and the exams for Practitioner and Master available later in the year. I believe the exam cost is similar to that offered by ICCP and DAMA is also looking to charge a recertification fee only at recertification time (usually every three years) rather than the annual fee required by the ICCP. Also note that anybody with an active CDMP from ICCP can convert it over to the DAMA CDMP free of charge for a limited time (last I heard the conversion period would end sometime in June or July). If you have not converted by then, you will need to retake all the certification exams for the DAMA CDMP. It may behoove those currently with the Mastery level to take advantage of this opportunity, given the additional requirements being established by DAMA to obtain the Master level. 
Location and Logistics:
