I wanted to give you an update on the CDMP program, with the latest information from DAMA International.

First, the new testing platform appears to be working pretty well with minimal miscues. This is a significant improvement over the old testing platform. The new platform will be available and used at Enterprise Data World (EDW) in Boston this year. Second, along with the Core Fundamentals exam, the following specialty exams will be available to take at EDW: Data Governance, Data Quality, Data Modeling, and Metadata. Third, DAMA-I is instituting a pay-if-you-pass approach at EDW. This is a fantastic opportunity to obtain your CDMP if you are in attendance!

This talk about CDMP got me thinking about education overall for data practitioners. Given the number and breadth of changes in the data industry over the last few years, it seems critical to me that we continue to broaden our understanding of 'all things data' whenever possible. Whether by attending a conference like EDW, taking a class at a university (or on-line), registering for a webinar, reading a book (or blog) by a data provocateur, or attending a local DAMA chapter meeting (hint, hint...), we should strive to continually build upon our knowledge as data practitioners. Save the Date - April Chapter Meeting


Join us on **Thursday, April 25**th for an informative day you won't want to miss! More information, including a detailed agenda, will be sent by e-mail.
